### MIXERS

Allen & Heath's three new small-format, USB-equipped mixers include the ZED-420 (16 mono and two dual-stereo channels — pictured), the ZED-428 (24 mono and two stereo channels), and



the ZED-436 (32 channels and two stereo). The series features a high-performance DuoPre padless preamp (a quality microphone circuit and an optimized line input circuit) rather than one preamp handling both mic and line signals. The mixers use a two-stage design with carefully controlled amounts of gain in each stage, offering high headroom and a low-noise, clean signal path. Other features include a responsive four-band, two-swept mids EQ with an in/out switch; six aux sends; and four sub groups, as well as direct outputs on each mono channel and separate L, R, and M main busses.
